As a family business, you need to understand the significance of the next generation. It really calms a lot of fears in your company. Mathews Brothers, over the years, has had a lot of small owners, but has only had four major family owners, in 158 years, and the Hawthornes' are one of them. Mathews Brothers has been in continuous operation since 1854, and is the oldest window manufacturer in the United States. Today, they still make putty glazed wood products, much like they did before the Civil War, as well as PVC, Composite Acrylic and AirCell core PVC windows, sold under their respective brand names.
